The group estimates that in the past 5 years the energy savings from the services offered by CESL Asia and its partners have eliminated around 17,300 tons of greenhouse gas emission, approximately the same effect as planting 727,900 trees that are 5 meters high.

Last year, CESL Asia achieved the Excellence Award for Environmental Performance in the Business Awards 2013 for providing solutions that significantly reduce environmental harm and foster resource savings. As a green company, CESL Asia has been implementing a series of environmentally friendly practices, such as installing air purifiers and replacing all office lighting with LED lighting systems that led to saving more than 30% in CESL Asia's electricity consumption.
