

CESL Asia forges new partnerships to mark 35th anniversary

CESL Asia celebrated its 35th anniversary on Monday with the announcement of several new partnerships at a ceremony with the aim of boosting technological innovation and sustainability in Macau.

During the anniversary celebration, CESL Asia formalised an agreement with EREN Group, which has made substantial equity investments totalling about MOP15 billion into 18 ventures focused on developing innovative technologies to conserve natural resources and reduce CO2 emissions.

According to the company, this joint venture will have exclusivity in promoting ACCENTA, a proven artificial intelligence (A.I.) technology that will enhance CESL Asia's FOCUS services, improving user comfort while saving energy, labour, and lifecycle costs.

During the event, CESL Asia also announced other partnerships, including collaborations with DELC – Distributed Energy Low Carbon Company, a startup specialising in energy transition, and Currie & Brown, a global provider of project management and advisory services.

Additionally, a strategic partnership is now underway between MPS and Guangdong Heavy Industry Architecture Engineering Group, a company with over 2,500 engineers in mainland China, working together on a tunnel construction project in Macau.



António Trindade, President and CEO of CESL Asia, highlighted the company's ambitions in his address, saying, "With the advancement and sophistication of the local and GBA economies, where adherence to the National Sustainable Goals for 2030 and 2060 encourages the adoption of technology and disruptive business models, we started to expand our technology capacities and our access to professional expertise and experience, establishing important new strategic partnerships for growth."
